Good way to create a transformation:

"Shape up the Shed" project of Westbury Community Garden

The "Shed" was a rusty orange shipping container that was an eyesore.

The transformation was to create a mosaic as a sign for the garden

This started a chain of events that included:

- •Moving the container to a council approved location in the garden
- •Clearing accumulated rubbish and materials from the fence line
- Painting the container
- Create the mosaic.
 - •Design input from community gathering in the garden
 - •6 different community groups representing all ages
 - •70 individuals all represented by engraved tiles in the river on the mosaic
- Adding a smaller shed made from pallets (another community project)
