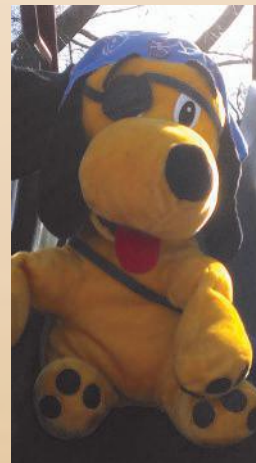
You never know what zany character might come wandering through the crowd with Pelican Puppets walk-about puppets.
